The December 13, 2022 board meeting of Turtle Lake Township convened virtually at 7:00 pm due to the Covid-19 declared pandemic. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the November 3, 2022 board meeting were approved as written & presented.

The minutes of the November 18, 2022 Board of Canvass were approved as written & presented.

Committee reports were given.

After short discussion, MS/P Wells/King that the January 10, 2023 meeting be held in person at the Township Hall at 7:00 pm with safeguards in place such as masks recommended, maintaining a safe distance, and hand sanitizer available. Roll call vote: Aye unanimous

An inquiry was made concerning internet at the town hall. They were informed that there is no internet connection at the hall. The cost of obtaining it there will be looked into.

Robert Brown addressed the board concerning a petition to blacktop the Agency Bay Road NW. The petition was emailed into the township earlier on December 13, but it did not include a map. He was made aware of the State Statute (365A) that addresses subordinate service districts and was informed that the township would need an original petition. Once that original petition is received the board can proceed with the subordinate service district process. MS/P Wells/King that the Township contact the township attorney concerning the issue. MS/P King/Wells that the Township be registered for MAT-U which is a program for township officers to watch training videos. Roll call vote: Aye-unanimous
