MS/P King/Wells to pay bills received and presented. Roll call vote: aye-unanimous


MS/P King/Wells to pay electric utility bill not yet received not to exceed \$250.00. Roll call vote: aye-unanimous
Payment authorized for check numbers 10827 to 10844 as approved.


A request was made by Todd Pehrson that financial information be placed on the website. The possibility of this being done will be researched regarding the legality of accomplishing this.
